Local Law No. 1 of 2017

Entitled: A Law Authorizing the Accepting of Certain Late Exemption Filings.

Be it Enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Blenheim as follows:

**Section 1.**

This local law is adopted pursuant to RPTL § 467 (8-a) to authorize senior citizens to request permission of assessing units to file late renewal applications for the RPTL exemptions allowed under § 467 upon good cause shown.

**Section 2.**

The Board of the Town of Blenheim, by enacting this Local Law does hereby authorize the Town Assessor to allow for the late filing of renewal applications for RPTL § 467 exemptions by senior citizens who have missed the application deadline for good cause shown, subject to the requirements of RPTL § 467 (8-a).

**Section 3.**

If any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this Local Law or the application thereof to any person, firm or corporation, or circumstance, shall be adjusted by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unconstitutional, such order or judgement shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this Local Law or in its application to the person, individual, firm or corporation, or circumstance, directly involved in the controversy in which such judgement or order shall be rendered.

**Section 4.**

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
